2021 Election Calendar

March 25 - Deadline for Candidates to submit Petitions to be on June 8 Primary Ballot

April 23 - No-excuse, early voting begins at Voter Registration Office, Lancaster Courthouse.

May 5 - Deadline to register to vote in Primary or update address. Online at: www.elections.virginia.gov

May 28 - Deadline to request Absentee Ballot online, fax, or mail.

June 5 - Last day for in-person early voting at Voter Registration Office.

Sign Electronic Petition for Candidates to be on Ballot in the Virginia Democratic Primary, June 8, 2021

Deadline is March 25, 2021

In order to be on the ballot for the June 8, 2021, Democratic Primary candidates must submit a petition with specific numbers of signatures of qualified voters by March 25, 2021. Due to the Coronavirus, you can now electronically sign and submit your signature for Candidate's Petition by going to https://www.vadempetitions.org/

What is this?

This site allows you to electronically sign petitions for Democratic candidates so that they can be on the ballot as candidates for the Democratic nomination in the June 8th, 2021 primary. We noticed different candidates were collecting these electronic petitions in different ways. This site allows you to sign multiple petitions at once for statewide and for House of Delegates candidates.

How does it work?

When you submit the form, your electronic signature is applied to an Adobe PDF form created by the State Board of Elections. That form is then directly sent to only the campaigns you select.

What happens with my data?

This site does not store or retain any of your data, with the exception that if you check the "Share this email address and my ZIP code..." box, they will keep your name, email

address, ZIP, and locality so that they can pass on your information to your local Democratic Committee. Your petition information, and in particular the last four of your SSN, are never stored or retained on the system. That information is entered into the petition form and sent to the candidates directly, as if you had completed a petition with them directly.

Why is the last four of my SSN required?

As part of the court agreement allowing electronic petitions, and because there is no real witness to your completion of the petition, the last four digits of your Social Security Number are required to submit your petition online. We understand that this information previously was optional, and if you do not feel comfortable completing this information online, we suggest reaching out directly to the candidates to offer to sign a paper petition.

Petition Signer Statement

I, the qualified voters of the district in which the above candidate seeks nomination or election, and of signed hereunder, do hereby petition the above named individual(s) to become a candidate for the office stated above in the Democratic Primary to be held on the 8th day of June, 2021, and we do further petition that his/her name be printed upon the official ballots to be used at the election.

Note to Petition Signer

Your signature on this petition must be your own and does not signify an intent to vote for the candidate.

You may sign petitions for more than one candidate.

Privacy notice:

This information provided will be checked against the official voter registration roll.

This form is available for public inspection, but your SSN, or any part thereof, will not be provided.

Fraud notice: Any willfully false material statement or entry made on this form by any person shall constitute the crime of election fraud and be punishable as a Class 5 Felony.

How to Vote Early in Lancaster County

Early voting for everyone begins April 23 at the Voter Registration Office at the Lancaster Administration Building. All excuses previously required for a voter to be eligible to vote in-person or by mail using an absentee ballot are eliminated. No-excuse, early voting is available during regular business hours 8:30 am to 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday, at the Voter Registration Office at the rear of the County Administration Building (follow the signs). In addition, on the two Saturdays before Election Day, you may vote at the Voter Registration Office.

Lancaster County Democratic Committee has nearly doubled the number of Democrats who voted locally in the Presidential Primary Election and Congressional Primary Election last year compared to previous years.
