Hearing On New Voting Districts

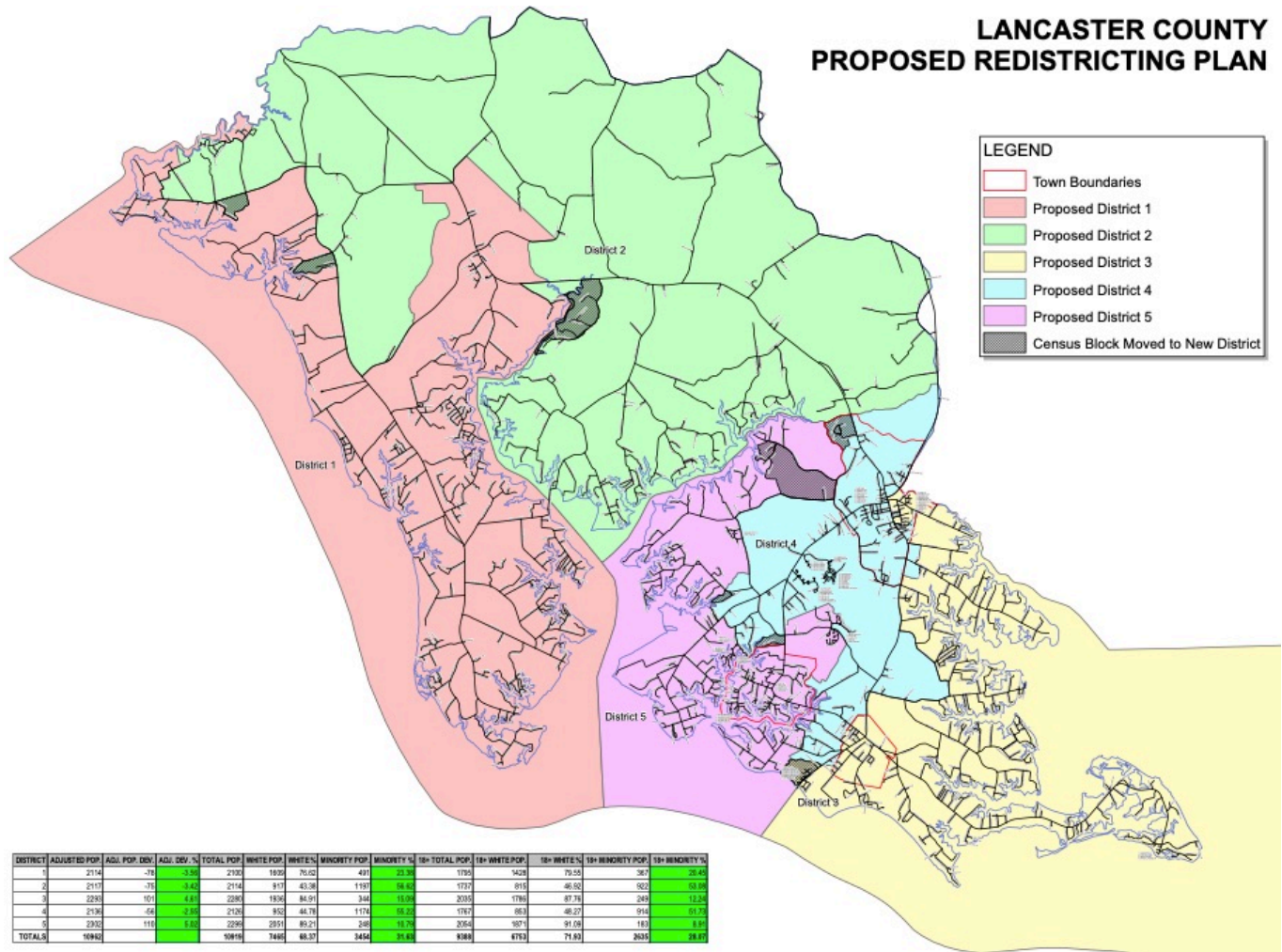
The Lancaster County Board of Supervisors invites the public to a hearing for the new election districts on Thursday, 2/24/2022 at 7:00 p.m. The in-person hearing will be in the BOS meeting room in the Lancaster County Administration Building, 8311 Mary Ball Road, Lancaster, VA 22503.

To join the meeting electronically, go to the county website at www.lancova.com and click on "Public Hearing for New Election Districts Scheduled for Feb 24th BOS Meeting" for details and how to ask questions.

According to the Code of Virginia, adoption of local election districts is required every 10 years. Several changes of note:

1. Voting districts were reduced from six to five with District 3 Precinct 302, Kilmarnock Baptist Church combined with other districts. If you voted at Kilmarnock Baptist Church, you will be notified by the Registrar of your new voting location.
2. Change the polling place for the White Stone District from White Stone Baptist Church (517 Chesapeake Drive) to the White Stone Volunteer Fire Department (579 Chesapeake Drive).

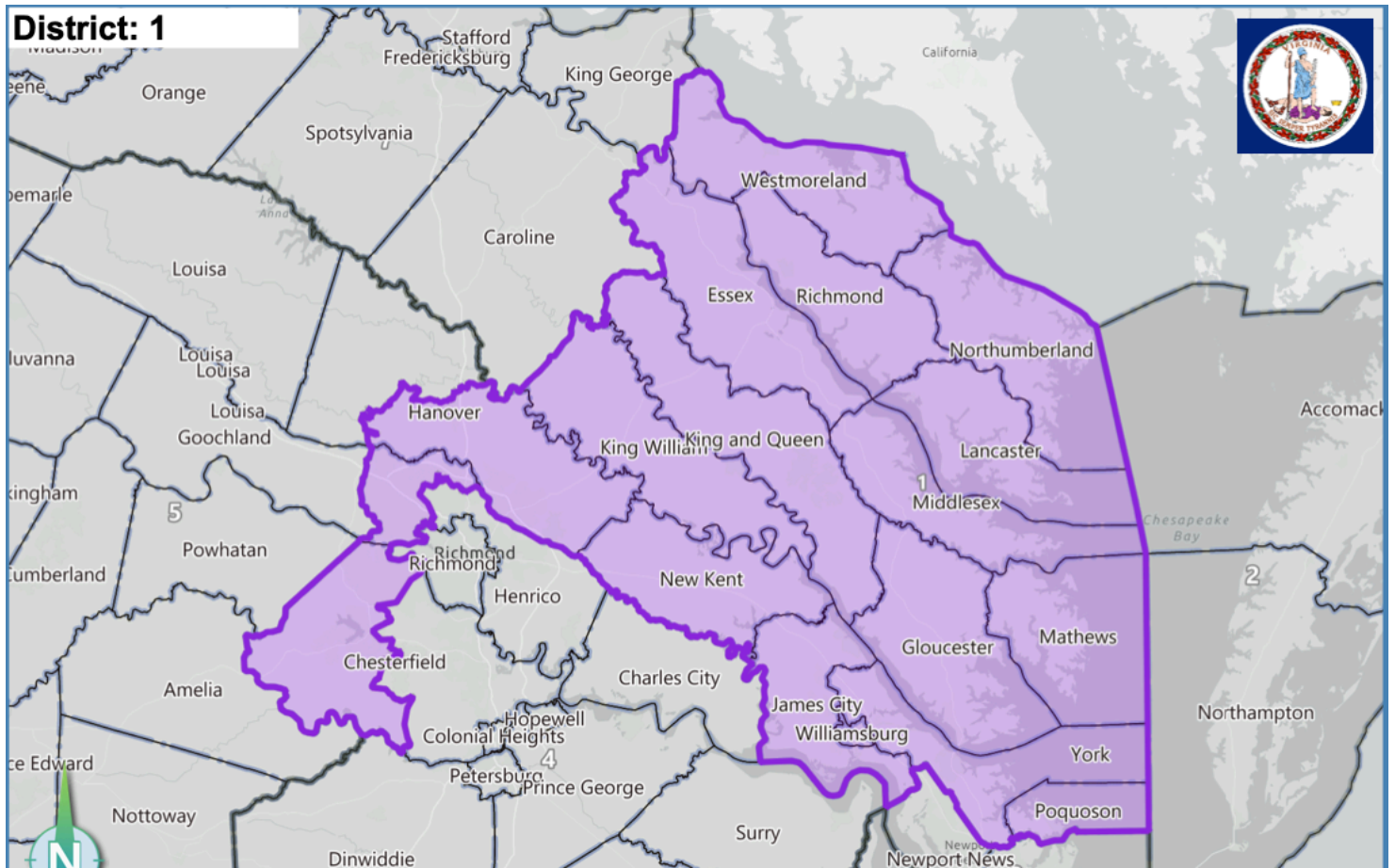
